

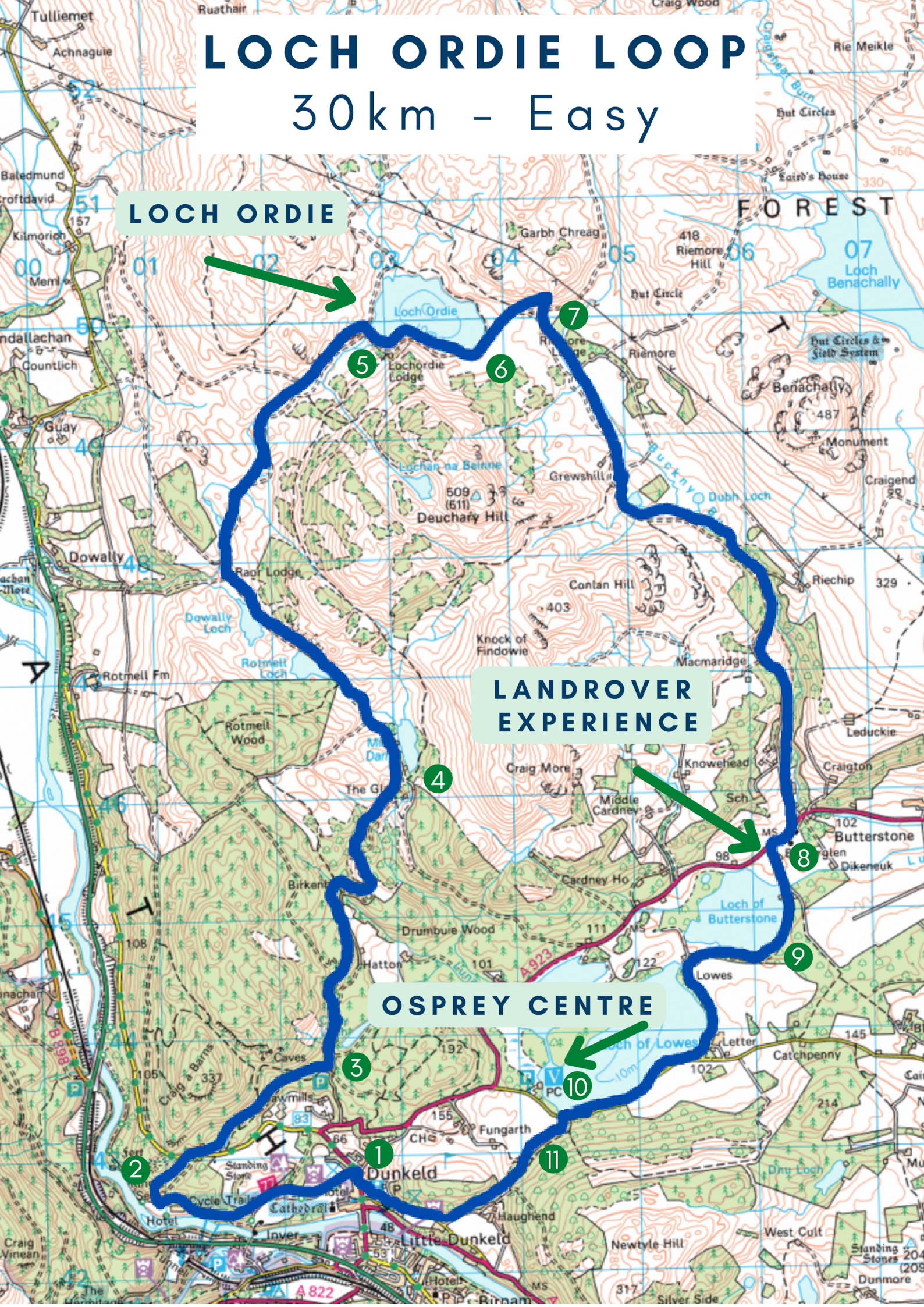

Loch Ordie Loop

30km



Step 1 - Hire a bike from Progression Bikes!

Step 2 - Cycle past the car park & take a left through the 'Dunkeld House Hotel' archway. Follow their back drive round the hotel, then up, over the road, onto a path round the Loch & up to Cally Car Park.

Step 3 - Cally Car Park can be reached more directly, by heading out of the village, and taking a right on the A923, then second left.

Step 4 - Follow signs to Mill Dam & Loch Ordie. At 'The Glack Kennels' take the left silver gate straight on to Mill Dam, a great spot for a snack.

Step 5 - Continue up, right at Raor Lodge, to Loch Ordie. Take a right following the 'Buttersone' sign. Lunch at the fishing lodge and a swim!

Step 6 - Cycle round the loch a little further, and once through the gate keep right and meet the tarmac estate road.

Step 7 - It is now flat and then downhill to Butterstone. Watch for cars coming up!

Step 8 - Take a right on the road for a few hundred meters, then take the left signed for 'Land Rover Experience'

Step 9 - Head through their car park, and onto a wooden track round the loch picking up a farm road back to Dunkeld

Step 10 - If you spot it, look for a left turn before the Loch of the Lowes Osprey Centre. It is a steep climb, so get in a low / easy gear before going through the gate!

Step 11 - The track climbs up and around the golf course before dropping back into Dunkeld. If you miss the gate, stay on the road past the Osprey Centre, and follow the signs to the village.
